


*"Broken Beauty includes many of Don McCullin's most iconic images, documenting human suffering over many decades from wars in Cyprus, Vietnam, Ireland and Lebanon to the Biafran famine and the AIDS epidemic in Africa. At its core, however, are a group of recent photographs - previously unseen - of ancient Roman sculptures. For Don, they are emblems of resilience and survival which are also reminders that all civilizations ultimately come to an end. Like his images of landscapes in Somerset and beyond, creating these works has provided him with a recuperative solace after the trauma of witnessing so much horror."*

## People Watching

Until 10th May, Dorset Museum and Art Gallery (DM&AG) will be showing *People Watching*, a collection of British portraiture, in a collaboration with the Ingram Collection.

The Ingram Collection is one of the largest publicly accessible collections of modern British art in the UK. Founded in 2002 by entrepreneur and philanthropist Chris Ingram, the majority of the collection was donated by Chris himself in 2016 to the Ingram Art Foundation. The organisation was established and funded to assist in fulfilling Chris's ambition to make modern and contemporary art widely available for public display.

The collection now spans over 100 years of British art and includes over 600 artworks. Many of these are by some of the most important British artists of the twentieth century, and by focusing on these it has allowed DM&AG to draw on its own important collection of modern British art.

The collection's main focus is on the art movements that developed in the early and middle decades of the twentieth century, with a particularly strong presence of modern British sculpture. Within the work that the curators have selected for this show is a very pleasing thread of Dorset artists

that were active during this period, as both artists and sitters. It grounds the exhibition in Dorset and makes it particularly relevant to its audience. The stand-out names of Thomas Hardy and Elisabeth Frink inevitably feature but alongside some of Dorset's lesser known talents. In Dorset during this time there were creative hot

spots of artists, writers, musicians and actors, socialising and feeding off one another's creativity. The writer Sylvia Townsend Warner features both in a photographic portrait by Cecil Beaton as well as with a collage she created, which has never before been on public display. Francis Newbery and Elsie Barling both depict the musicians David Brynley and Norman Notley, and there are also paintings by lesser known female members of large creative families, Winifred Nicholson and Gertrude Powys.

With sections of the exhibition dedicated to subjects such as Leisure and Play, Family and Relationships, People at Work, and Beyond the Real, the exhibition allows us to deep dive into different narratives. A self-portraits section explores how modern and contemporary artists portray themselves, reflecting on self-perception and the role of self examination in their creative process. It features a particularly captivating self-portrait of the abstract modernist Terry Frost and a woodcut by the Bloomsbury Group's Roger Fry, printed by fellow members Leonard and Virginia Woolf.

Well known artists Barbara Hepworth, Augustus John and an early representational piece by Bridget Riley highlight the calibre of work in this exhibition, but they're shown alongside more contemporary pieces and later acquisitions to the Ingram Collection. It boasts a growing number of works by young and emerging artists since establishing the Ingram Prize, an annual purchase prize created to celebrate and support the work and early careers of UK art school graduates, demonstrating its dedication and commitment to the UK art scene.

Ingram Collection Director Jo Baring says: "This exhibition is a celebration of the power and versatility of portraiture - how it can reveal, conceal, question and transform. *People Watching* offers a unique opportunity to experience modern British art through the lens of the human face, both familiar and fantastical."

This absorbing exhibition isn't just for portrait lovers but also for those lovers of twentieth century art, human connections, relationships and history in general.

# Headlines

Athelhampton House, in the heart of Dorset, is one of England's finest Tudor Manors. The Great Hall was built in 1485 and remains mostly unchanged, boasting original features such as a hammer-beam roof, carved stonework and stained glass windows. There are 20 rooms open to visit, all showcasing magnificent period details, from the 1400s to the 1930s. On the second floor of the historic East Wing, next to an old servant's bedroom, there is a new art gallery.



This bright attic space overlooking stunning grounds has the capacity to hold a considerable body of work. Here, John Lowe will be showcasing a rather appropriate collection of work. Known for his house portraits, John originally trained as an architect and is a lover of all ancient buildings. He has previously held the role of Historic Buildings Officer for Dorset County Council and was involved in initiatives such as best thatching practice and windows guidance.

His years of knowledge and experience come together in his recent publication *Dorset Houses*, which takes us from the Bronze Age right through to the Twenty First Century via his beautiful illustrations. His work is mostly mixed media on paper, inspired by traditional western architectural imagery and drawing techniques, elements of Japanese printmaking, and the illustrations of Alan Sorrell and Posy Simmonds. John has the ability to make his house portraits bright, friendly, and magnanimous, they glow from inside and are very obviously homes and not just bricks and mortar.

A dozen remarkable writers, journalists and publishers will again transport the audience with stories of their travels to the four corners of the globe. 





## While We're Watching

"Materials and methods echo the artists' shared role as storytellers in this multi-disciplinary exhibition by six artists who invigilate at Hauser & Wirth Somerset. Alannah Sallis's *Beautiful Disguises* speaks to the allure of surface and the emotional complexity hidden beneath, using clown imagery to explore persona, masking, and the human psyche. Becca Croxton works mainly with woodcut printmaking, carving connection to identity through the layering, and exploration of place and time. Fiona Campbell's organic sculptural textiles use labour-intensive processes to rework discarded materials, treating matter as non-hierarchical gestures of care, repair and resistance. Kate Plowman's mixed media images, sculptures, and mosaic works are made largely from collaged recycled materials including maps and clothing. Leslie Glenn Damhus's paintings are steeped in mythology, fairytales, religious iconography and animal symbolism in art. Her playful sense of humour combines the historical and the contemporary, weaving modern-day cultural reference through Quattrocento imagery. Penny Hartley's *Model Village* uses drawings and soft abstract buildings to represent structures that we live and work in, of physical settlements and ideas of community."

# Angela Charles

Angela Charles is a painter. As we talked we both remembered when I wrote about her work in 2005 and she mentioned her favourite red pencil. All that remained was a tiny stub but it still delivered a magical thin red line. Angela can't see that red line any more. A gradual change in her sight ten years ago accelerated and she went from being that carefree person navigating the stones on Chesil beach, painting sea and landscape, to someone who only has very limited peripheral vision.

She still spends time on the beach, a sandy one, but now accompanied by her beloved guide dog Flynn. She has changed from a non-dog person to sharing every moment of her life with one, and that is the least of the adjustments she has had to make.

There is a significant pause in our conversation when she describes the moment when she was given her diagnosis and was told that she would go blind and that there was no treatment. For a visual artist it was catastrophic. She relinquished her job as a curator and people assumed that she would also give up painting. She didn't!

Her palette became brighter and the mark-making bolder. She had a 'muscle memory' of how to mix colours and has assistive technology to help. And if all else fails she can ask a human! When people commented on the change in her work she sidestepped the reasons. It was a long time before she felt comfortable telling people, and the galleries that showed her work, that she was losing her sight.

She supplemented acrylics with the thick pens beloved of graffiti artists which hold so much liquid paint it feels like painting. Some of her compositions changed to reflect the change in her vision. She tends to place larger areas of colour centrally, with more detailed mark-making located at the edges where scribbled lines are visible to her limited peripheral vision.

Art has always been Angela's life. She studied Fine Art Textiles at Goldsmiths and colour was always her passion. She felt that that defined her. Now she feels more defined by her blindness than she does by her practice as an artist.

However she recently rediscovered her love of screen-printing. The back-lit screens allowed her to see the strong monochrome marks. "It made me excited to see lines and marks that I thought were lost to me forever."

Collaboration has become another way of working. Sculptor Lawrence Dicks, who carves stone, made some pieces for her

based on classical sculpture. She found the process of drawing on the uneven surfaces challenging, feeling that she was almost 'destroying' his work. In another collaboration with Björk Haraldsdóttir, a ceramicist, the flat sides of Bjork's vessels were easier to decorate, and the resulting marks seemed to reference landscapes.

Visits to exhibitions continue to be important but instead of low-lit historical works she gravitates towards shows like the

Gilbert and George at the Hayward Gallery and the Ashmolean's recent Radiohead show. She still remembers what Radiohead record covers looked like and the excellent audio guide supplemented her memories.

She relies heavily on AI powered smart glasses to tell her what she is looking at. They are much better than headphones, which are disorientating because they remove her ability to navigate a space by sound, exacerbating her lack of sight.

In new work Angela is moving away from "memory of place, more towards memory of experiences, I am starting to look at disability art, which I see as a positive move, going forward."
